

Important Clinical Clearance Information for Nursing Students

Welcome to Nursing! As you enter your program there are **5** mandatory clinical clearance items that must be completed prior to starting any clinical placement. These are required by our placement sites and students cannot attend clinical without them. This summer is the ideal time to get these out of the way so you are ready to go come September!

1. Vulnerable Sector Police Clearance – must be a “vulnerable sector” check
 - Obtained from your local police services, please follow this [link](#) for information on obtaining this clearance
 - Upload the completed document to the St. Clair College Student Information System (SIS) as per instructions below

2. CPR with BLS – completed **since** June 2022.
 - Although many providers state the CPR certification is good for 2 or 3 years all health care professionals must renew their CPR annually. If you wish your CPR to be valid for your entire academic school year it needs to be done after June 1st.
 - Upload the completed document to the St. Clair College SIS as per instructions below

3. Standard First Aid- Done one time for the program, does not need to be renewed
 - Upload the completed document to the St. Clair College SIS as per instructions below

4. N95 Mask Fit – please wait till September to get your N95 mask fit. This is when you find out which placement site you will be attending. Different sites have different N95 mask requirements.
 - Once completed, upload the completed document to the St. Clair College SIS as per instructions below

5. Passport to Health- Updated annually by our Health Centre at the College
 - To obtain your Passport to Health, you must have this form filled out by your primary care provider: <https://www.stclaircollege.ca/sites/default/files/inline-files/Medical-Requirements-Form.pdf> *Please note all immunizations and medical requirements are mandatory, including 2 doses of the Covid vaccine and the booster.
 - Upload the documents to the St. Clair College SIS as per instructions below
 - The nurses at the St. Clair College Health Centre will then review your documents and grant you the “Passport to Health”.
