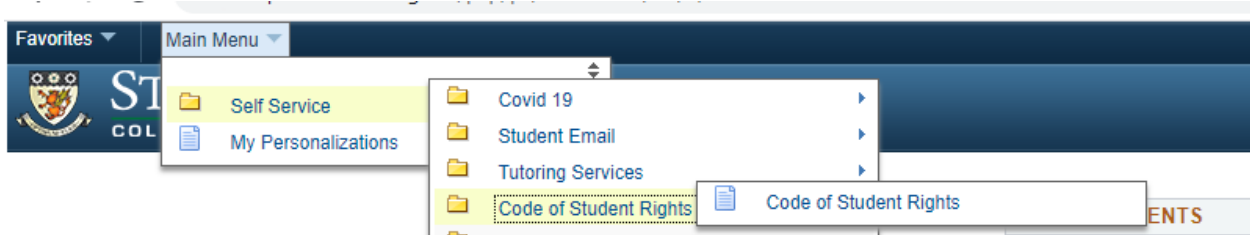


Code of Student Rights and Academic Integrity Statement

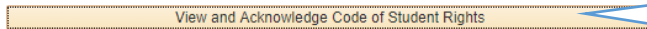

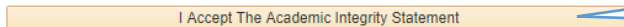
