The Indigenous Student Bursary is an award provided to Indigenous students with financial need who are attending postsecondary programs and/or training programs at either an Ontario publicly-assisted college and universities, or approved Indigenous postsecondary education and training institutions.

ELIGIBLITY CRITERIA:

- you must self-identify as having Indigenous identity and/or heritage.
- you must meet the Canadian citizenship requirements.
- you must meet the Ontario residency requirements.
- you must be enrolled in the current academic year of study.
- you must demonstrate financial need (as identified by the financial aid office for students attending publicly-assisted colleges or universities, the Indigenous Education Council for students attending Indigenous Institutes, or through their OSAP application).
- you must complete the Indigenous student declaration of Indigenous student status.
- you must complete the Indigenous Student Bursary Application, including the budget.
