

Police Criminal Record Check/Police Vulnerable Sector Check – Unavailable: Student Under 18 Years

*Student will be required to submit proof of age identification to Synergy. Examples of acceptable identification would be a Driver's License, Health Card or Passport.

I am aware that for students aged 18 and older, a clear Police Criminal Record Check (PCRC)/Police Vulnerable Sector Check (PVSC)* is required as part of student participation in the placement component of the program.

As I am not yet 18 years of age and cannot obtain a Police Criminal Record Check (PCRC)/Police Vulnerable Sector (PVSC) from my local police service, I hereby acknowledge, along with my Parent/Legal Guardian (by signing this form):

- I am personally responsible to apply for a Police Criminal Record Check (PCRC)/Police Vulnerable Sector (PVSC) from my local police service once I turn 18 years of age.
- I am personally responsible to upload the Police Criminal Record Check (PCRC)/Police Vulnerable Sector (PVSC) to Synergy Gateway for verification upon receipt.
- Failure to provide a Police Criminal Record Check (PCRC)/Police Vulnerable Sector (PVSC) within 60 days of turning 18 years of age will exclude me from participating in my placement. This can jeopardize my academic standing and may lead to program withdrawal, without refund.
- I am aware that students are required by host agencies/employers to provide a current Police Criminal Record Check (PCRC)/Police Vulnerable Sector (PVSC) from a recognized police service for their placement. Individuals who have been charged or convicted criminally and not pardoned, will be prohibited from proceeding to placement, as per St. Clair College Policy 1.1.10.
